It is ordinary people, working in their own communities, who have irrevocably shattered the pernicious and paternalistic myth that people in resource-poor countries could not manage complex, chronic prevention care and treatment programs on a national, in fact continental, scale.

This directory names and provides information on hundreds of organisations, institutions, and groups that are a key part of the fabric of three communities in an informal settlement of Nairobi, Kenya called Mukuru. The residents of those three communities—kwa Njenga, kwa Reuben, and Lunga Lunga—face tremendous challenges that are real and long-standing. And yet, this directory is evidence that the residents of Mukuru are working hard to create organisations and relationships and activities to meet those challenges head-on. And they are succeeding.

People who are not residents of Mukuru often assume that this community is dire need and that it is only a place of desperation. This is not the case. While the needs are real so are the resources and capacities of the people who call Mukuru home. Sometimes the assumptions of those on the outside keep them from seeing those resources and capacities. This directory makes them visible.

All of the organisations in this directory were named by residents of Mukuru as assets for improving the health and wellness of the people of Mukuru. The assets that were named vary in focus—some organisations provide social services, others provide economic opportunities, and still others provide educational services, for example. They vary in size and capacity—some are large and offer a broad spectrum of services, while others are smaller and more focused. Despite this variety, all of these assets share at least one thing in common: they were named by the residents of Mukuru as a resource that are making a difference in the lives of the people.

This directory would not exist without the assistance of colleagues representing organisations both inside Mukuru and from other parts of Kenya, including: the Government of Kenya, The Partnership for an HIV Free Generation, the Kenya Office of the President's Emergency Plan for AIDS Relief (PEPFAR) of the United States Government, St. Paul's University, Micato Safaris/America Shares, and Hope Worldwide Kenya. In addition to the efforts of individuals who are part of these various organisations, some individuals provided tremendous contributions to this project and should be named. Reverend C.B. Peter from St. Paul's

University played a key role in facilitating workshops and analyzing the findings. An impressive group of young people worked to survey all of the organisations that residents named. Vincent Mutuku led this group, consisting of Penninah Munyiva, Lucy Manthi, Moses Wahor, Michael Mwanga, Michael Kinyanjui, and Anthony Mutuku. They are clearly some of the most important assets for the people of Mukuru. Duncan Muthuma helped to coordinate various activities of this group and helped to handle the various logistical needs of those of us from Emory University in Atlanta; his knowledge and wisdom were the key to this project on more than one occasion. Ms. Debbie Jones was the initial force behind this project, coordinating it in her position in the Interfaith Health Program at Emory University. The methodology behind the mapping employed in this project was developed in collaboration between Emory and colleagues in the African Religious Health Assets Programme (ARHAP). Steve de Gruchy was a member of ARHAP and was on the faculty of the University of Kwa Zulu Natal in Pietermaritzburg, South Africa. He played a formative role in developing and making this methodology applicable in local communities across southern and eastern Africa. Steve died unexpectedly in February 2010 and we miss him and his commitments but are grateful that they continue to bear fruit after his death. Finally, and most importantly, this directory is only possible because of the women, men, and young people who live and work in Mukuru. They shared their knowledge, questions, concerns, wisdom, and insights with us at every step along the way. The information contained in this directory represents the assets that they created to address the challenges they face. The extent to which these assets are valued in the community represents the trust that has been developed over time among the residents of Mukuru and these organisations.
