

### Provide Service with Respect, Gratitude, and Love

One of our patients was a 46 year-old disabled and homeless male, who did not have regular access to basic hygiene needs and transportation. Though he had disability medical insurance, the lack of a means of transportation made it virtually impossible for him to get regular flu shots.

Walgreens Store Manager, Omar Elkabchi, approached the man without hesitation and provided him with a flu shot.

The patient was so happy and grateful after receiving the shot that he said, "Thank you blue angel!"

### Hard to Reach-Homeless Population: Be Flexible -- Compassion in Action

Tzu Chi worked with San Gabriel Valley Homeless Consortium to establish the relationship and provided flu clinic service at winter shelter sites from 7-10 p.m. twice per week. We had a total of 30 reach-outs of medical and dental services at 6 church sites.






